Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Building Work Update

We hope this letter finds you well.

We would like to inform you about some upcoming building work that will take place during the summer holidays at our school. We understand the importance of keeping you informed about any changes that may affect your children's learning environment. To ensure the safety and comfort of our children, we will be replacing the heating pipework and radiators in the Y1/2 classrooms and upstairs areas, as well as installing a new boiler.

This essential maintenance work will begin during the summer holidays and is expected to be completed before the start of the autumn term. Additionally, we will address any damp issues within the school premises during this period.

We will be preparing the building for this work on Thursday and Friday of this week. According to the schedule provided, all work is planned to be completed by September 2nd, ensuring a smooth start to the autumn term. We understand that staff will have a great deal of work to do to get the classrooms ready for the children once the maintenance is finished. The spaces need to be completely cleared for the work to be carried out and then set up again for the children.

Due to the project being scheduled to be completed at the very end of summer, we need additional time to prepare. As a result, the governors have agreed to an additional INSET day on Tuesday, September 3rd. This means that all children will return to school a day later than planned, on Wednesday, September 4th. This extra day will allow us to ensure the school is ready for a safe return and complete all of the annual, compulsory safeguarding training with staff.

We hope you understand our reasoning behind this decision. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any concerns.
